Enrolled in the College of Agriculture or intend to declare an agriculture major

Cumulative grand point average of 3.0 is preferred

Ag background or work-related experience in agriculture

Be a member or a child of a member of Farm Credit Services of Mid-America

Must submit an essay on how you plan to use your major in the chosen career (tab 4 of this application)

Winner will be invited to make a brief presentation at an FCS Customer Appreciation Event (held in the summer)

Graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply

Employees or children of employees and directors or children of directors are not eligible to apply
