FCS AGRICULTURE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Scholarships to those pursuing degrees in agriculture are awarded each year to customer-members of Farm Credit Services of Mid-America or their children based on academic record, leadership qualities and community involvement. Farm Credit awards 36 scholarships – 18 scholarships valued at \$1,500 and 18 scholarships valued at \$1,000 – through this scholarship program each year.

Recipients must:

- Be an incoming freshman, sophomore, junior or senior in good academic standing for the academic year in which the scholarship is received. Graduating high school seniors are eligible to apply as incoming freshmen.
- Be enrolled in the college of agriculture or declare a major in agriculture at any four-year college within the United States.

- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better (preferred).
- Have an agricultural background or work-related experiences in agriculture.
- Be a member (or a child of a member) of Farm Credit Services of Mid-America.
- Submit a one-page essay on how they plan to use their major in their chosen career.
- Employees, children of employees, board members or children of board members are not eligible to apply.

The deadline to apply for this scholarship is the last day in February of the year in which you apply. Scholarship recipients are selected in March and all applicants will be notified by late April.

4-H AND FFA SCHOLARSHIPS

Farm Credit awards scholarship through the state offices of the 4-H and FFA in Indiana, Kentucky, Ohio and Tennessee. Recipients do not need to be members of Farm Credit Services of Mid-America. However, they must be a member of the 4-H or FFA in our four-state territory. Please contact your local 4-H or FFA office for an application. UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS

Farm Credit works with colleges throughout Kentucky, Ohio, Indiana and Tennessee to provide scholarships to students studying agriculture.
